## ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP

**Application Deadline: September 30** 

#### **Mission Statement:**

To promote agricultural ideals, education and entertainment for community enrichment as a volunteer organization.

#### Vegreville Agricultural Society Scholarship

**Award**: The Vegreville Agricultural Society awards two \$500.00 scholarships annually, weighted equally between academic achievement and community involvement.

**Eligibility:** Shall be available to any post-secondary student commencing (or currently enrolled in) any year of an accredited program in the Province of Alberta degree or diploma. Preference will be given to applicants 25 years of age and under. A student is only eligible to make one successful application. Failure to supply required documentation will result in disqualification.

**Selection Criteria:** Offspring of directors, former directors, permanent employees, and members of the Vegreville Agricultural Society will be given first consideration. Academic achievement and community involvement will be determining factors.

**Educational Prerequisites:** The applicant must have the required prerequisites acceptable to the receiving institution - a letter from the school indicating your acceptance is to be included along with a copy of the Department of Education transcript and forwarded to the Scholarship Committee prior to the deadline.

**References:** Candidates are to provide two reference letters pertaining to the two main areas of consideration (academic achievement & community involvement). Candidates may be called for a personal interview.

**Deadline:** Completed application with all areas completed, acceptance letter, reference forms and copy of transcript are to be submitted to the office of the Vegreville Agricultural Society.
